EVANGELISM MINISTRY LEADER SCOPE OF MINISTRY

Purpose: To keep the congregation focused on the work and needs of evangelistic opportunities at home and abroad.

- **A. TIME REQUIRED:** About five hours per month for a minimum of one year.
- **B. QUALIFICATIONS:** One who has a keen heart for evangelism. One who is well-organized, self-motivated and able to delegate as well as being sensitive to the needs of others.

C. SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Commune with the Lord.
- 2. Answer directly to the Board of Directors.
- 3. Prayer Teams need to be developed before any evangelistic crusade takes place along with any training and scheduling of Altar Workers as well as those involved in Follow-up.
- 4. To ensure that any visiting evangelist (and team) is properly cared for by either a billet (who will care for lodging and meals) or a motel room. To also ensure that an honorarium is given according to the Honorarium Policy in co-operation with the Financial Director.
- 5. To be actively involved in each and every service where evangelism is the focus. To ensure that adequate supplies of altar worker material (i.e.- Bibles, tracts, follow-up forms, etc) are close at hand and properly distributed.
- 6. To oversee ongoing evangelistic efforts such as Prison Ministry; Tract Distribution; Gospel Signs.
- 7. To co-ordinate special projects as the needs arise with a focus on evangelism (i.e. Books, Bibles, literature; Christmas gifts; crusades).
- 8. To ensure that the church has the birthdays and anniversaries of all evangelism families that we support. Also to ensure that cards are mailed for these special dates.
- 9. To co-ordinate the various types of fund raising for evangelism as the need arises.
- 10. To develop a system to record all incoming and outgoing correspondence as well as any monies gained through fund raising in co-operation with the Clerical & Financial Directors.
