MISSIONS MINISTRY LEADER SCOPE OF MINISTRY



Purpose: To keep the congregation focused on the work and needs of the missionaries at home and abroad.

A. TIME REQUIRED: About five hours per month for a minimum of one year.

B. QUALIFICATIONS: One who has a keen heart for missions. One who is well-organized, self-motivated and able to delegate as well as being sensitive to the needs of others.

C. SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Commune with the Lord.
2. Answer & report directly to the Board of Directors.
3. To develop a system to record all incoming and outgoing correspondence as well as any monies gained through fund raising in cooperation with the Financial Director.
4. To encourage the congregation to write their missionaries on a regular basis. Self-addressed envelopes with information about the missionary along with a few guidelines need to be enclosed for each letter.
5. To update the congregation each Mission's Sunday by highlighting a missionary letter. It will be especially important to emphasize any needs that the congregation could become involved with. Prayer needs to be encouraged for any special requests.
6. To ensure that any visiting missionary is properly cared for by either a billet (who will care for lodging and meals) or a motel room. To also ensure that an honorarium is given according to the Honorarium Policy.
7. To co-ordinate special projects as the needs arise. (i.e.. - clothing; vehicles; books, Bibles, literature; Christmas gifts).
8. To ensure that the church has the birthdays and anniversaries of all missionary families that we support. Also to ensure that cards are mailed for these special dates.
9. To be actively involved in any special missionary events (i.e. - Mission's Convention/Seminar).
10. To co-ordinate the various types of fund raising for missions (i.e. - Christmas Gifts) as the need arises.

WHEN WRITING LETTERS TO OUR MISSIONARIES

Thank you for your willingness to write to one of our missionaries. It is important that several things be considered when writing a letter.

1. We don't want the missionaries to have to increase their mailing list. Please use the self-addressed envelop provided. All letters should to be returned to our Mission's Ministry Leader, Adrienne Toews at 754 Sandfield Crescent, Cornwall, ON, K6H 5C3. She will pass on any information in the letter to you after gleaning any information that needs to be shared with the congregation on Mission's Sunday.

2. It is best not to ask too many questions about their work. Quite probably they have already let our church know the information you are requesting. It would be more appropriate if you tell them about yourself and what is happening in our church. They really appreciate the personal touches that are shared in these letters. It makes them feel a part of a greater body of believers. It also shows them that someone is caring about what they are doing.

3. Keep the information uplifting. Don't tell them about problems you are having in life. Remember, they need to also be encouraged. Bless them with a thought, poem etc.

4. Make sure you pray for them and let them know you are doing so.

We are so thankful that you have decided to become involved in ministering to those who have given their lives to touch others. Your thoughtfulness will not go unnoticed by God.

Dwight and Lynn returned originally to South Africa (Transkei) which was the birthplace of Dwight. Dwight's parents (Rev Art & Gladys Lagore) were instrumental in seeing the churches multiply to more than 80 in their 30 years of ministry. There was also a Bible College raised up that served the area very well.

Lynn's parents (Rev. Earl & Ruth Trekofsky) oversaw an orphanage in Brazil called Mount Horeb Training Center. The home church of this work is in Edmonton, Alberta and is called Richfield Christian Assembly.

Dwight and Lynn felt to move north in their ministry and began working in the war-torn country of Mozambique. They are now involved in what is known as SAM (South Africa Ministries). They purchased an airplane to fly into areas that are presently close to any access. Dwight completed his pilot's license number of years ago. It has been a great advantage to them to have the plane.

Lynn is a registered nurse so her training has brought them an advantage among people who are very poor and normally do not receive proper medical attention. They have a daughter and son who have returned to Canada for training and jobs.

Dr. Jim Humphries began this ministry called Project L.A.M.B.S. (Light Abroad Mobile Bible School) in 1997. He began with his wife Irene by bringing this mobile Bible College to Jamaica. Their first graduating class (after 3 years of study) took place during the Easter Convention in 2000. They have returned many times and raised up teachers who are now training their own people.

They have also trained lay persons across Canada. They also became involved in the training in the Ukraine churches. Invitations were been received from Poland, Germany, Africa, China and a number of other countries.

Irene passed away in March 05 of cancer. Jim traveled to Myanmar (formerly Burma) where he met his new wife Hkaw Win. They have been training many pastors in that country as well as in Japan and China (underground works). Hkaw Win oversees 80 Day Cares.

Their diplomas were awarded through Providence Theological College/Seminary in Otterburne, Manitoba. They have produced over 20 courses. Pastor Brad has taught the "Biblical Theology" Course and developed and taught the "Development and Education" course. Our church was involved with their bi-yearly studies in 1998-2000.

Dr. Jim just received his Doctor of Ministry degree from Providence Theological Seminary in 2000. Hkaw Win received her Master of Ministry degree. They have done a remarkable job under very difficult conditions.

Presently they are working on establishing a full financial support by monthly commitments. Pastor Brad and Dr. Humphries served together in Fort McMurray from 1986-88.
